Transfer ESR objects

You can transfer objects of the **Deployment unit**, **Process component**, **Service interface**, **Operation**, and **Business object** types from connected ESR servers to your ARIS database.

Prerequisite

- You [updated](#) the license key. If your license key enables the **<_ARIS_Connectivity_for_ESR>** functionality you can use the ESR content. This license key extension is free of charge but available only to SAP customers who purchased an ESR license. The license key can be obtained from Software AG.
- You [added](#) an ESR server.

Procedure

1. For example, in the **Navigation** bar of the **Explorer** module, double-click the ESR server you want to connect to. ESR servers are marked with the server symbol .
2. Enter the connection data in the wizard and on the last page, click **Finish**.
3. Open the software component version whose ESR content you want to transfer.
4. Click the content to be transferred, hold the mouse button down, and drag the content to the target database. The merge procedure starts. Depending on the amount of data, the procedure may take a while. Due to licensing issues, models and certain objects are not transferred from ESR.

After the process is completed, you can use the objects in your databases and, for example, [transfer](#) WSDL from the source elements in ESR to the objects. The **SAP services** tab in the **Designer** module is available for [navigation](#).

Note

Due to licensing issues, objects must not be transferred from a database to your ESR servers.
